Our pool will be inspected on April 10th so it is ready for our May 1st opening. Webbing is going to be installed around the fence for privacy and to keep the leaves out of the pool.

# **Landscape & Irrigation Report**

- Repairs on Sprinklers have been completed for January and February. However, there are still major repairs to be made.
- Report all leaks immediately to the Board!! Running water = higher bills = damage to the landscape.
- Landscaping project behind Stonecreek Drive underway soon. We are working to keep the cost under \$15,000.
- We are currently working on a new bid for our landscaping contract, as well as the project behind Stonecreek Dr. Both of these projects must move forward as soon as possible.

### **Good News!**

The City of Carrollton project committee met with CVHA Board members to announce that they are in the final stages of plans to replace all sewer lines, water lines, streets and curbs within Country Villas. Estimated start on all repairs is August, 2024. Project is estimated to take 18 months with an estimated completion near the end of 2025.

- Phase 1: City Sewer lines will be replaced.
- Phase 2: City Water lines will be replaced.
- Phase 3: City streets will be replaced, including curbs. All curbs will meet ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990) requirements.
- Concrete pads inside the circles on Creekwood Court and Meadow Stone Court will be removed and replaced with ground cover.
- Some trees will be targeted for removal due to location (most of these have been identified and are part of the circles).
- Some driveways will be replaced based on the slope.

Once all the plans have been finalized, the City of Carrollton will host a meeting inviting all homeowners to attend a presentation explaining the plan, expectations and answer any questions.
